ABOUT THE HIKES

Uniacke Estate Park Museum features 7 beautiful walking trails where you can expect to see a number of natural sights including lakes, waterfalls, brooks, a variety of forest types, lush marshes, and huge boulders left behind by glaciers.

45 Min Hike: The Drumlin Field Trail veers off the Martha Lake Loop through woodland along the lakeshore with a panoramic view of Uniacke House at the top of the drumlin. The footing is easy to navigate with wide pathways.
