# ABOUT THE HIKE

Uniacke Estate Park Museum features 7 beautiful walking trails where you can expect to see a number of natural sights including lakes, waterfalls, brooks, a variety of forest types, lush marshes, and huge boulders left behind by glaciers.

**45 Min Hike:** The Drumlin Field Trail veers off the Martha Lake Loop through woodland along the lakeshore with a panoramic view of Uniacke House at the top of the drumlin. The footing is easy to navigate with wide pathways.

**90 Min Hike:** The Red Spruce Loop is a challenging walk of higher difficulty. Encounter magnificent hemlock; a stand of straight Red spruce; brooks and a mossy bog. Return along the edge of Lake Martha.
